



SPORT FILM FESTIVAL SHORT FILM COMPETITION

I. GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. The 4th annual Sport Film Festival, organised by The National Olympic Committee of Lithuania and Vilnius University's Health & Sport Centre, will hold the SHORT FILM COMPETITION on "Inclusion through Sport" (hereafter, Competition).

II. OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION

- 2. To promote creativity of film makers by offering a platform to present their short films on sports' theme and creation of a solid, friendly and healthy society through sports.
- 3. To encourage society to learn about various sports through the visual arts.
- 4. To promote film makers to expose the connection between sports and culture.
- 5. To spread the message about sports and physical activity as a way of solving emerging challenges, like national, religious, racial, sexual, etc. exclusion.

III. PARTICIPANTS

6. The competition is open to everyone. Each participant can join several creative groups. The number of the members in a team is unlimited.

IV. TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

- 7. **Duration:** April December, 2018
- 8. Stages of the Competition:
- 8.1. <u>preparatory</u>: the Regulations of the Competition and registration form are published on the websites of the National Olympic Committee of Lithuania <u>www.ltok.lt</u> and Vilnius University's Health & Sport Centre <u>www.ssc.vu.lt</u>;
- 8.1.1. the duration of the registration till **14th of September, 2018 m.** Registration form must be sent via email to sportshorts@ssc.vu.lt.
- 8.2. primary:
- 8.2.1. the creation of the short film;
- 8.2.2. the submission of created short film in MP4 format;
- 8.2.3. the review and evaluation of Competition's Jury.
- 8.3. conclusive:
- 8.3.1. screening Competition's short films, selected by the Jury, during the Sport Film Festival, and introducing it to the society;
- 8.3.2. Festival's audience open voting;
- 8.3.3. summarizing and publishing the results of the Competition;
- 8.3.4. the announcement of the winners of the Competition, awards.

9. Film requirements:

- 9.1. work must match the theme of the competition;
- 9.2. length of the work must be 2-15 minutes;
- 9.3. film authors must comply with the Republic of Lithuania Law on Copyright and Related Rights. Only those works, which in no way could be a plagiarism or a copy of a work, created by others, will be submitted to the Competition;
- 9.4. film can be created independently or with a help of the professionals, directors, specialists or students, studying art or directing;
- 9.5. if the film is submitted in non-Lithuanian language, subtitles in English are necessary;
- 9.6. film makers are free to choose the genre of the film they are making;
- 9.7. only those films, which were created not earlier than 2016, can participate in the Competition;
- 9.8. film can be created using a variety of video tools, cartoons, computer graphics, etc.;
- 9.9. no harmful or illegal information can be used in the film, and the provided information must comply with the requirements of the Laws of the Republic of Lithuania.

10. Submission of a film:

- 10.1. Finished work must be sent via email to sportshorts@ssc.vu.lt, using Wetransfer or Dropbox programs by 20th of October, 2018, at 5 p.m. Films, which are ineligible or sent later than a mentioned deadline, will not be considered;
- 10.2. one team can submit one work;
- 10.3. Submission of a film means that participants of the Competition agree with all the conditions mentioned in these Regulations.

11. Evaluation:

- 11.1. short films will be evaluated by the Competition's Jury and the audience of the Festival;
- 11.2. short films will be evaluated by the Competition's Jury, which will be formed of Experts in Sports and Cinema;
- 11.3. the members of the Jury will be published on the websites of the National Olympic Committee of Lithuania www.ltok.lt and Vilnius University's Health & Sport Centre www.ssc.vu.lt;
- 11.3.1. Competition's Jury must review submitted short films, evaluate them, according to the criterias, and select the winner till 1st of December, 2018. The decision of the Jury will be recorded.
- 11.4. During the Sport Film Festival, the audience will be invited to express their opinion by voting for the most favorite film, which will also be rewarded.
- 11.4.1. the voting will take place after the screening of the films by filling out questionnaires distributed by the organizers of the Festival;
- 11.4.2. the Team of film makers, which will get the biggest ammount of the votes from the audience, will be rewarded.
- 11.5. Evaluation criterias:
- 11.5.1. relevance to the topic;
- 11.5.2. idea;
- 11.5.3. presentment of the topic;
- 11.5.4. originality.

12. Cash prizes:

- 12.1. The winner elected by the Competition's Jury will be awarded with a monetary prize of **1000** Eur;
- 12.2. the winner elected by the votes of the Festival's audience will be awarded with a monetary prize of **1000 Eur.**
- 12.3. The winners will be awarded during the Sport Film Festival.
- 13. Short films that do not comply with the requirements of these Regulations are not considered by the Jury, and are not included in the Festival's program.
- 14. The results of the Competition will be published on the websites www.ssc.vu.lt. The winners of the Competition will be informed individually.

- 12. The Organisers remain the right to use the works of Competition for non-commercial purposes without paying the honorarium.

- 13. The Organisers have the right to change the Regulations of the Competition.
